- 9% experience homelessness.



KY Degrees Awarded by Age




In 2018-19, 50% of credentials were awarded to people 25 and older






Kentucky Surpasses Needed Progress






Projected Decline in High School Graduates











In 2017, 45.5% of Kentucky's working-age adults had postsecondary degree or credential.






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
- Raising college-going & retention for traditional students to the level of highest performing states increases attainment to 49%.
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- Raising college-going, retention, & graduation for traditional students to level of highest performing states increases attainment to 50%.
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


- We must enroll and graduate a greater portion of the 1.2 million adults with no credential to reach 60%.


Percent of Kentucky Adults with an Associate Degree or Higher


