Introductory
Remarks Mr. John Hall called the meeting to order and welcomed attendees. Introductions were made.

Discussion Mr. Hall reviewed the agenda of the meeting and asked Dr. Handley to begin with the review of the Bucks for Brains brochure.

Dr. Handley gave copies of the Bucks for Brains brochure to those present. The electronic copy was sent to all policy group members. A brief discussion of the finished brochure ended with approval of the document.
