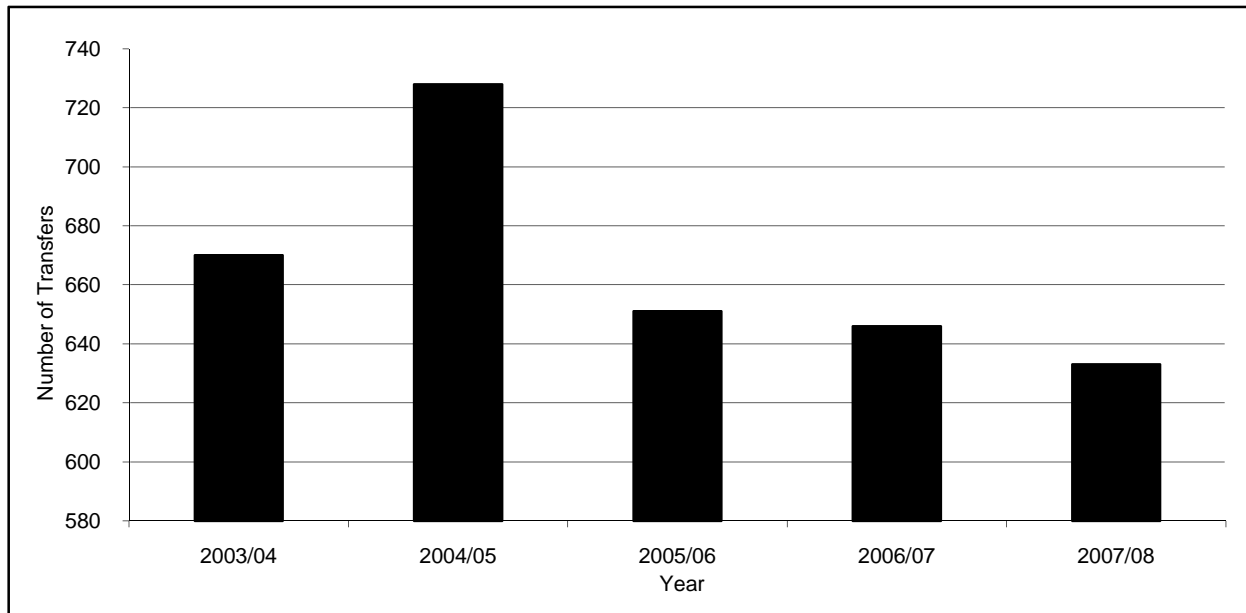


A first-time transfer student is identified by the four-year public or independent institution's student record file (type1). Only those students transferring from a KCTCS institution are selected for these reports.

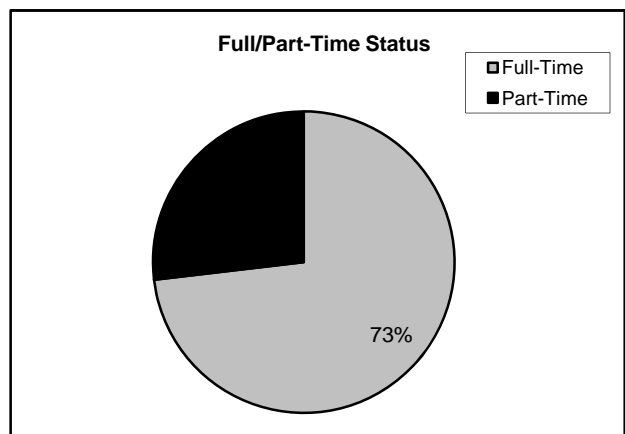
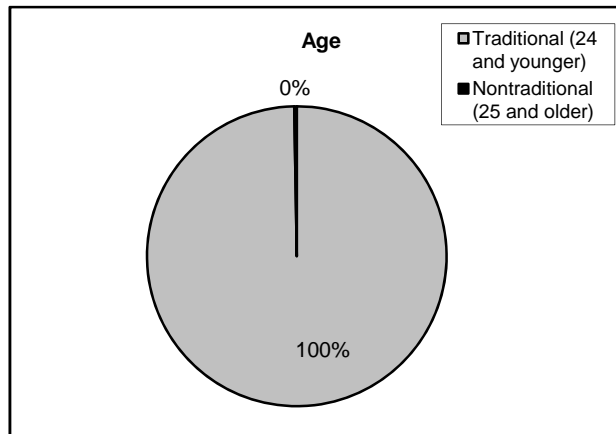
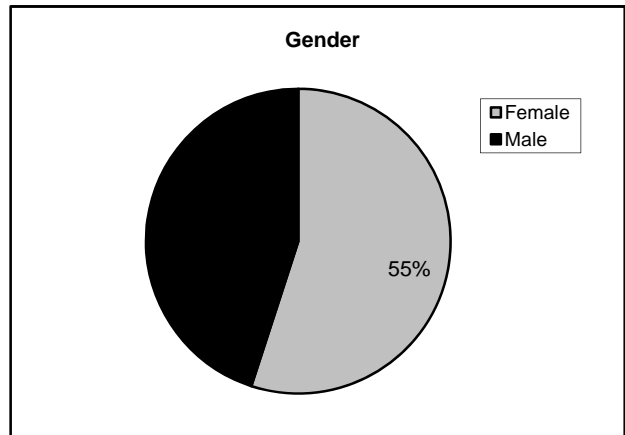
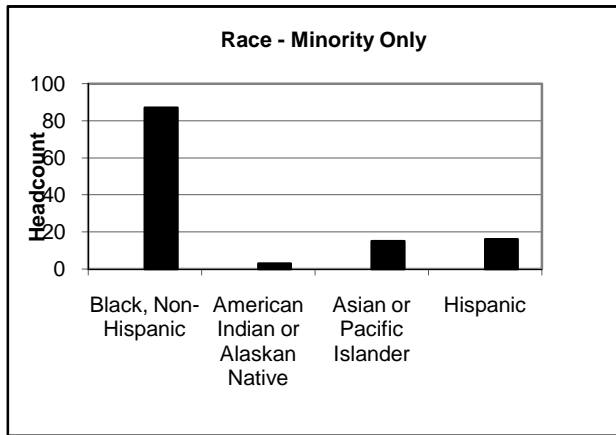
**Graph of First-Time Transfers by Year**

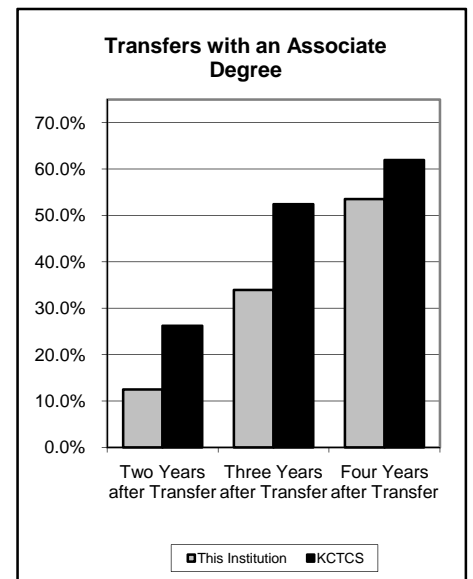
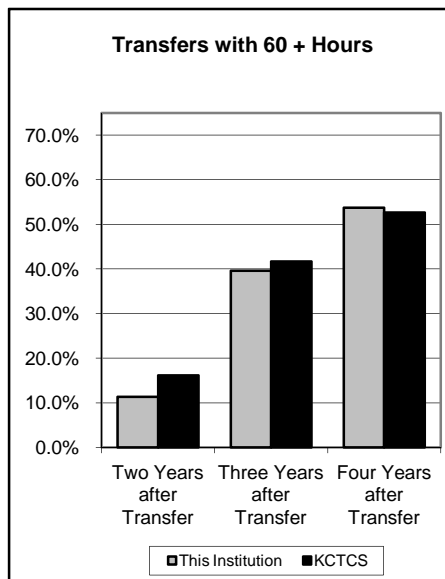
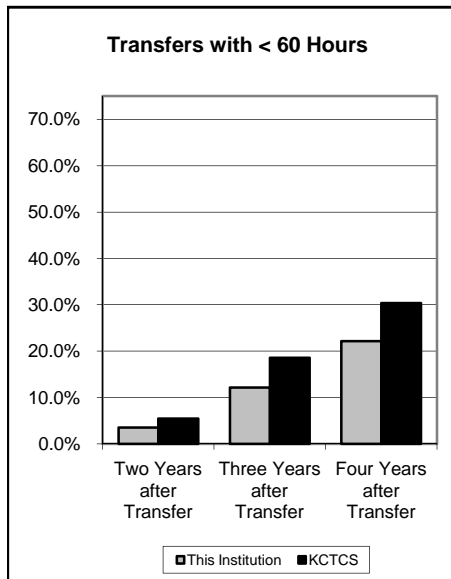
