Transfer Pipeline

39 Percent Intend to Transfer

39 percent of KCTCS students reported that transfer to a four-year university was a major reason why they were in college (2010).¹

8,099 Students Transferred In-State

8,099 students transferred KCTCS credit to an in-state four-year institution in the 2008-09 academic year:²

- ✓ 4,445 students transferred an average of 44 credit hours from KCTCS to an in-state four-year institution (public or independent).
- ✓ 3,654 students at in-state four-year institutions transferred in an average of 14 credit hours earned at KCTCS as visiting students (public or independent).

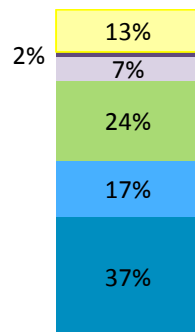
Out-of-State: An additional 2,734 students transferred from KCTCS to a four-year institution out-of-state by 2008-09.

22 Percent Transfer Rate

In 2008-09, 22 percent of KCTCS students successfully transferred to an in-state four-year institution (public or independent).² Note: Students had to complete 10 non-developmental credit hours at each institution to be counted as a successful transfer.

2010 Transfer Student Survey: Credit Applicability and Transfer Services

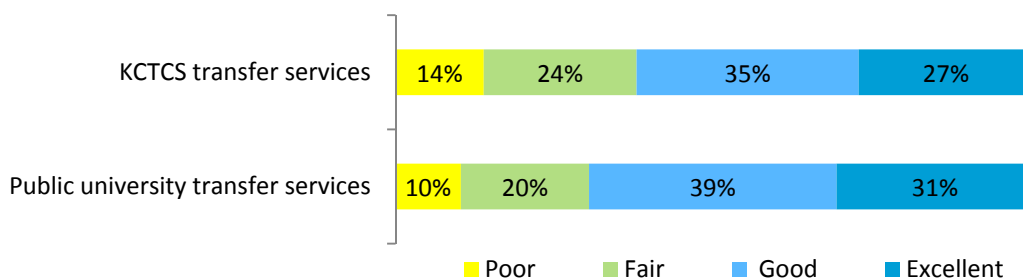
Overall, 61 percent of transfer students surveyed reported that either all transfer credits transferred toward their degree (37 percent) or they expected that not all of their credits would transfer (24 percent).³



KCTCS Credit Transferred Toward Degree

Transfer Services Ratings



The majority of transfer students rated the transfer services offered by both KCTCS and public universities as good or excellent: 62 percent at KCTCS and 70 percent at the universities.³
