In accordance with KRS 164.945 - .947 and 13 KAR 1:020, and the documents submitted, **Daymar Learning, Inc. d/b/a Daymar College's** conditional license to operate as an in-state, postsecondary institution in Kentucky is hereby amended to reflect the following campus relocation:


The effective date of the change of location reported by the college in its application was July 17, 2017. The college notified CPE in May 2017 of the upcoming change of location and the college was prepared to submit its application for change of location to CPE. However, the college has had an application for licensure with the Commission on Proprietary Education (Commission) pending since December 2016. Therefore, rather than submit an application for change in location with CPE, the college updated its application with the Commission around June 13, 2017 to reflect the new address as it was anticipated that the college would be under the jurisdiction of the Commission by the end of June 2017 and before the move. However, it has come to the attention of Daymar College and CPE that the earliest the Commission may vote on the application will not be until October 25, 2017. Accordingly, CPE has amended the college's conditional license to reflect the change of location, and CPE continues to extend the college's conditional license until it obtains approval from the Commission.

This license remains conditional per CPE's letter to the institution dated June 30, 2017 as amended September 19, 2017, subject to CPE's letter to the institution dated January 17, 2017 and the understanding that the institution will continue working with CPE and the Commission on Proprietary Education to ensure it is meeting the requirements to operate in Kentucky.
