Dear Chancellor South:

The Council on Postsecondary Education (CPE) has received South University – Online’s Supplementary Application for Notification of Change in Accreditation and Licensure Status pursuant to 13 KAR 1:020 due to South University – Online’s placement on probation by SACSCOC. In accordance with KRS 164.945 - .947 and 13 KAR 1:020 Section 7(1)(e), South University – Online is hereby placed on conditional license for failure to comply with SACSCOC’s Core Requirement 2.11.1 (Financial resources and stability) and Comprehensive Standard 3.10.1 (Financial stability) related to CPE’s Standards for Licensure set forth in 13 KAR 1:020 Section 8.

This license is conditioned upon South University – Online:


1. Providing CPE with a copy of its Third Monitoring Report, which is due to SACSCOC by September 8, 2017.
2. Providing CPE with any correspondence to or from SACSCOC related to the February 3, 2017 probation letter, including SACSCOC’s response to the university’s Third Monitoring Report.
3. Providing any other updates upon CPE request until such time as the university is no longer on probation with SACSCOC.

Once CPE receives assurance that South University – Online has satisfied these conditions, CPE will remove South University - Online from conditional license status. A conditional license may not exceed two (2) years. Failure to satisfy the conditions in that time frame may result in revocation of South University – Online’s license or an extension of the conditional license upon request of the institution with supporting justification.
