In accordance with KRS 164.945 - .947 and 13 KAR 1:020, this is to confirm that the **Spalding University's** conditional license with respect to the Doctor of Physical Therapy program (CIP code 51.2308) is hereby extended to November 21, 2026.

The licensure of this program remains conditioned upon the university submitting approval documentation from CAPTE to CPE once received. We received from the institution on February 19, 2021 the approval documentation from SACSCOC dated February 12, 2021.

This current conditional license is valid through November 21, 2026, at which time CPE will need to determine if an additional extension may be issued if the university has not obtained CAPTE accreditation by that date.
