Research provided by the Central Florida Educational Ecosystem Database reports transfer students can be assisted in their path to graduation if we align practices and focus on three data supported solutions:

- Reduce Transfer Shock through effective coaching/advising aligned via a Major Readiness Coaching Academy.
- Reduce Time to Degree by assisting students achieve Major Readiness though using unified and shared course sequencing and course equivalency database which identifies and verifies students who are the most major ready.
- Promote retention in major though data enriched student level supports.
