Multi-State Collaborative on Military Credit (MCMC)

- Partnership of 13 states
- Translate military training competencies into college credit
- Share best practices related to articulation of credit, certification and licensure, communication, and data and technology



Kentucky's MCMC Efforts

- Campus reps worked with CPE to create statewide definitions of military active, military veteran, and military connected students.
- Campus reps worked with CPE to create Guiding Principles for awarding military credit.
- CPE is currently working with some campuses to create a table of articulated credit related to Army MOSs.

 A coordinating body for over 1,800 colleges and universities


 Coordinates faculty teams to evaluate military training and make credit recommendations
