Study context & scope


This is a **1-year diary-study** with 30 students to **map their admission journeys** across the 8 Public Kentucky Universities.

The goal of this study is to **better understand the student experience** of the admissions journey all the way through matriculation, following the students' in-the-moment experience.

The project will result in **8 journey maps of the current state experience**. The learnings and artifacts will inform the strategy for the great admission redesign.

How might we leverage a deeper understanding of the student experience as a means to alleviate their stresses and elevate their joy throughout the college admission journey?

Digital diary study and co-creation workshops



STUDY TIMELINE

Students began completing weekly tasks and reflection diaries in the study platform Indeemo on October 1st. Phase 1 concludes in May 2025 when 24 students will be selected to move into Phase 2. The diary study concludes in August and the final deliverables will be completed by October 2025.


