The Executive Committee of the Council on Postsecondary Education met June 1, 2012, at 1 p.m. (ET) at the Blue & Co., LLC, offices in Lexington, Kentucky.

ROLL CALL

**Discuss President
Evaluation Survey
Responses**

The purpose of the meeting was to open and review the responses to the surveys pertaining to President King's annual evaluation.

Pre-postage paid envelopes were provided to each member of the various constituents groups in order to return completed surveys to Blue & Co., LLC, the Council's independent certified public accounting agency. The surveys remained unopened at the accounting agency's offices until the Executive Committee met June 1.

- 62 surveys were sent out; 47 were completed.
- 13 members of the General Assembly were given the opportunity to respond; 6 responded.
- Governor Beshear and three of his staff were given the opportunity to respond; 3 responses were received from the Governor's office staff.
- 8 university presidents, the KCTCS president, the AIKCU president, and five select community and technical college presidents were given the opportunity to respond; 10 responded.
- 14 Council members were given the opportunity to respond; 14 responded.
- 10 CPE senior staff were given the opportunity to respond; 9 responded.
- 6 state policy leaders interested in postsecondary and adult education were given the opportunity to respond; 5 responded.

Council staff retained the survey responses to prepare a summary for the Executive Committee to review at its June 21 meeting.
