Dear President Cox:

In accordance with KRS 164.945 - .947 and 13 KAR 1:020, Chamberlain University – Louisville is hereby conditionally licensed as an out-of-state, postsecondary institution to offer the following program at 9901 Linn Station Road, Louisville, KY 40223:

- Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) – CIP Code 51.3801

This license is conditioned upon the institution:

1. enrolling no students until faculty who meet the requirements established in 13 KAR 1:020 Section 8 (5) (d) 5 are hired for instruction of the program; and
2. providing any other updates upon CPE request until such time as the university has hired faculty.

This conditional license is effective through the end of fiscal year, **June 30, 2027**. Once CPE receives assurance that the university has satisfied these conditions, CPE will remove the university from conditional license status. A conditional license may not exceed two (2) years. Failure to satisfy the conditions in that time frame may result in revocation of the university's license or an extension of the conditional license upon request of the institution with supporting justification.
