In accordance with KRS 164.945 - .947 and 13 KAR 1:020, Cincinnati State Technical and Community College's license to operate as an out-of-state, postsecondary institution in Kentucky is hereby amended to reflect the following location of a licensed instructional site in Kentucky:

This license is conditioned upon Cincinnati State Technical and Community College – Florence:

1. submitting to CPE approval documentation from the Higher Learning Commission once obtained.
2. submitting to CPE approval documentation from the Commission on Accreditation of Allied Health Education Programs once obtained.
3. submitting to CPE approval documentation from the U.S. Department of Education once obtained.

Once CPE receives assurance that Cincinnati State Technical and Community College – Florence has satisfied these conditions, CPE will remove Cincinnati State Technical and Community College – Florence from conditional license status. A conditional license may not exceed two (2) years. Failure to satisfy the conditions in that time frame may result in revocation of Cincinnati State Technical and Community College – Florence’s license or an extension of the conditional license upon request of the institution with supporting justification.
