# CALL FOR POSTER SUBMISSIONS!

We invite each campus or academic unit to bring a poster and easel to display it showcasing an adult-friendly practice, program, or policy. These will be displayed throughout the convening and each campus will have an opportunity to highlight their initiative during the reception on Feb 6.

Here are a few tips and guidelines to get you started:

- Bring a physical poster (typically 22 in. by 28 in.) to display at the convening. Send an electronic copy of your poster (saved as a png, jpg, or gif) to [heather.faesy@ky.gov](mailto:heather.faesy@ky.gov) by February 1, 2020.
- Your poster does not need to summarize a research project, so feel free to include any sections/headings that suit your particular needs. These may include:
  - 1) Statement of the Problem or Background – A description of the problem you wish to solve/overcome with this strategy, program or policy.
  - 2) Proposed Solution – an overview of the practice, program or policy adopted by your campus.
  - 3) Highlights – a summary of key highlights, program components, features, etc.
  - 4) Results – what occurred as a result of this practice, program, or policy, and any next steps?
- We encourage you to use photos, graphs, and other images in your design. There are many PowerPoint and InDesign templates available online to assist you. Some sample guidelines for poster development can be found here: <http://www.personal.psu.edu/drs18/postershow/>
