Needs Analysis

- Maysville was ranked 3rd in 2021 in overdose deaths
- KY is ranked 2nd amongst states in drug overdose deaths with a mortality rate of 53.4 per 100,000 population.
- Employment of social and human service assistance is projected to grow 17% from 2020 to 2030
- High need amongst Business & Industry and Mental & Behavioral Health Partners for trained specialist



Human Services Program Goals & Successes

- August 2022 was the first year of Human Services at MCTC
- Enrollment goal for year 2 was 30 students, currently at 121 students
- Goal for degrees conferred was 10, we've had 20 graduate with the AAS degree
- 1 full time instructor, 2 adjuncts
- All online courses
- Offering Human Services classes at EKCC (Eastern Kentucky Correctional Complex)- had 36 enrolled in Human Services classes last Fall
- MCTC Workforce has applied for an INSPIRE grant with Goodwill Industries and one of the career paths will be participants taking the APSS training, with hopes to continue to Recovery Coach, then full AAS Human Services Degree

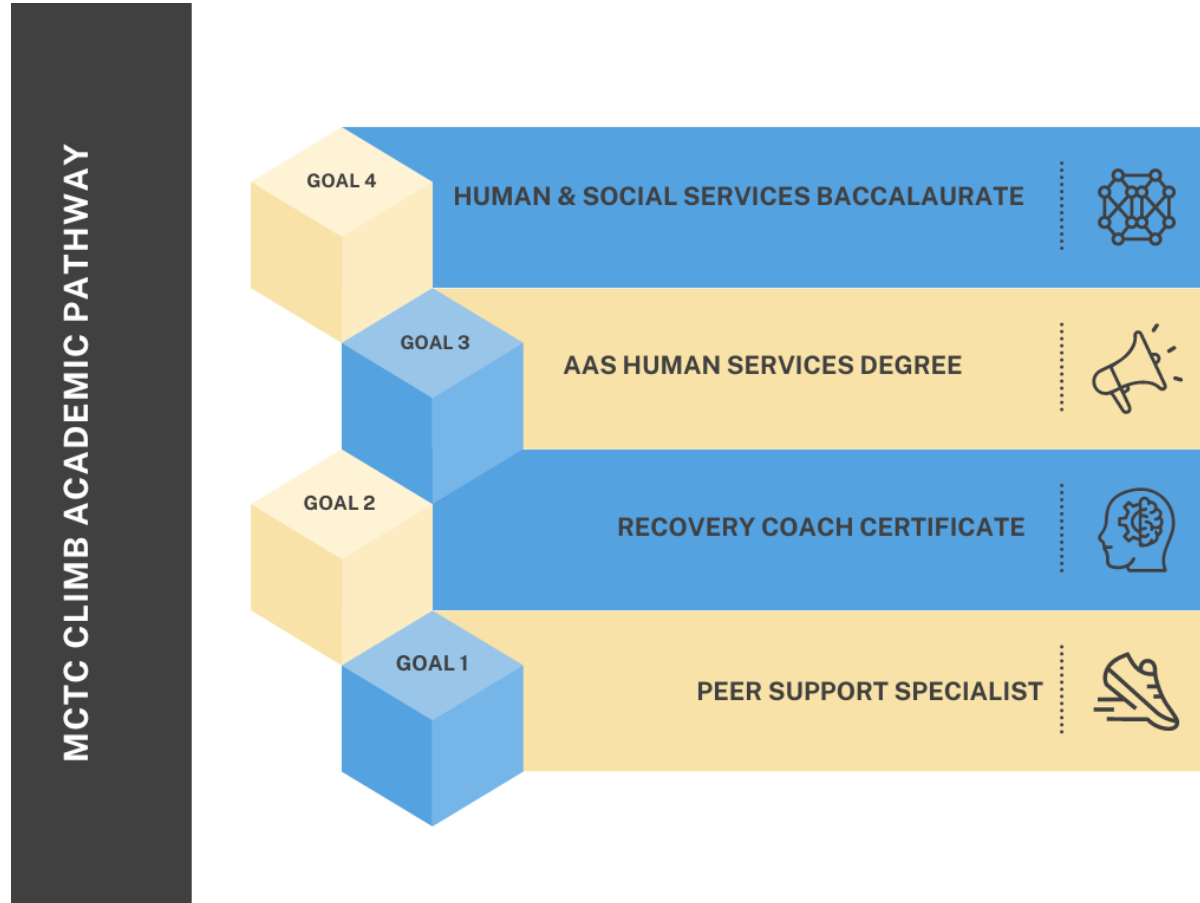
Educational Pathways
