What is Beacon?

How Beacon Works

Users simply describe the student's situation in natural language. Beacon asks clarifying questions about location, urgency, and specific circumstances, then returns tailored recommendations including:

- Specific resource names, addresses, and contact information
- Hours of operation and eligibility requirements
- What documentation or identification the student should bring
- Prioritized options (e.g., “try this first” or “backup option”)
- Campus-specific resources available to enrolled students

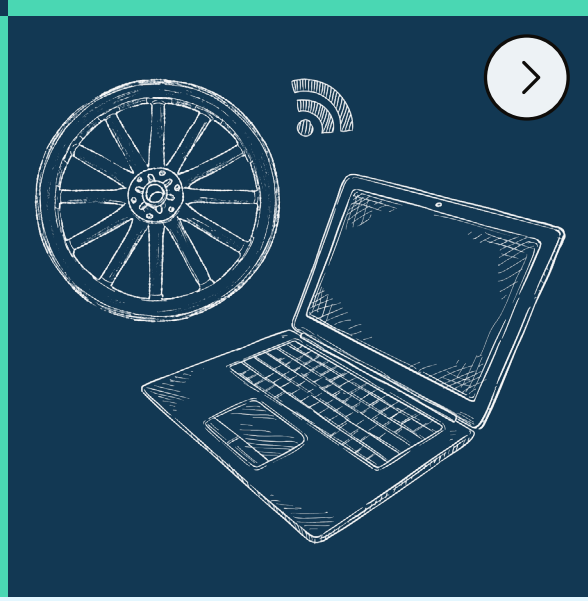
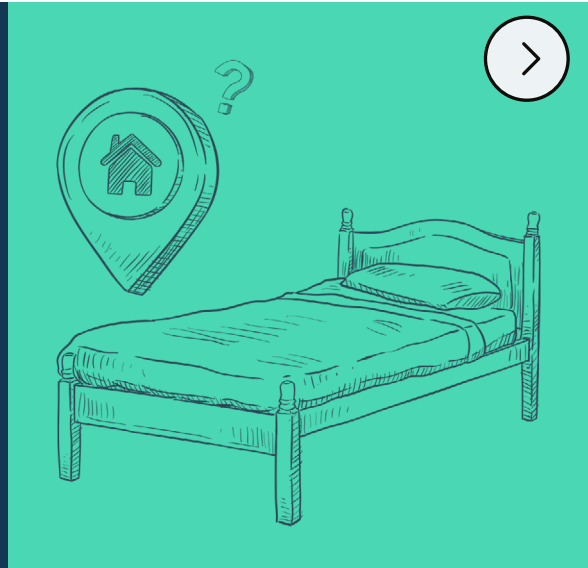
