Thomas More University Dual Credit Program

The Thomas More University Dual-Credit Program offers eligible high school students the opportunity to take college courses at a reduced tuition rate while exposing them to college rigor, Thomas More's culture and so much more. The Dual-Credit Program collaborates with multiple Tri-State schools to encourage intellectual growth and benefit the students in the program. Eastern Kentucky University Dual Credit Program

EKU Dual Credit is a dual-enrollment program for eligible high school juniors and seniors that offers the opportunity to take college level courses for dual credit, high school credit and college credit, at a reduced tuition rate. EKU offers this program to public school, private school, and home school students in Kentucky. EKU is partnered with many schools and school districts to offer a variety of general education courses, career pathways, and student's future major required courses. Their students can take these courses in their high school (if offered), online, and at their main campus in Richmond, Ky or at their regional campuses in Corbin and Manchester, Ky.
