Healthcare Training Scholarships Partnership Proposals

Deadline: October 31, 2024

The Kentucky Council on Postsecondary Education (CPE), through the Healthcare Workforce Investment Fund, seeks partnership proposals from eligible healthcare partners and healthcare programs, as defined in [KRS 164.0401](#), for healthcare training scholarship.

I. Background

Created in the 2023 Regular Session of the Kentucky General Assembly through HB 200, the Healthcare Workforce Investment Fund (HWIF) is a groundbreaking framework for public/private partnership. The legislation shares responsibility between industry and government to carry out a dedicated mission - to cultivate a robust healthcare workforce in Kentucky. The core objectives are twofold: providing educational scholarships to students pursuing programs targeting critical workforce needs in healthcare professions (at least 65% of funds) and recognizing and rewarding excellence among Kentucky healthcare professional education and training programs (up to 35% of funds).

II. Funding Opportunity

CPE is excited to announce a second round of funding, awarding \$842,246.00 in matchable funds to eligible healthcare programs. This additional funding opportunity is available to eligible programs that did not receive a HWIF award during the first round.

III. HWIF Priorities – Healthcare Training Scholarships

Through statute, CPE is directed to evaluate and prioritize awarding funds to healthcare training scholarship partnership proposals that plan to (1) address the specific needs of a historically underserved county, (2) improve racial and ethnic diversity within a specific designated healthcare credential, (3) reduce the workforce demand of a specific eligible healthcare credential that is determined to be among the highest in demand in the state, or (4) from a healthcare partner with fifty or fewer employees.

IV. Healthcare Training Scholarship Partnership Proposal Submission

The submission period for the second round of partnership proposals will close on October 31, 2024. Below is the proposal form that should be used.
