


KY Higher Education Successes

Enrollment Pressures


The number of American high school graduates is expected to fall from 3.9M in 2025 to 3.5M in 2037, an 11% decrease.




Kentucky's Looming Enrollment Cliff

Between 2012-22, KY's high school graduate cohort size increased about 6%.



Between 2022-35, KY's high school graduate cohort size is projected to decline about 3%.


